
## **Construction Notice**

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department and Sunland Asphalt & Construction, LLC will be resuming construction of pedestrian improvements on 24th Street where it crosses the Highline Canal. These improvements include:

- Reconstruction of approximately 205-feet on 24th Street over the Highline Canal for a consistent roadway
  width with continuous curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the east side of the roadway, and new curb on the west
  side of the roadway.
- Provide pedestrian and maintenance access along Highline Canal by constructing new pedestrian curb ramps and driveways.
- Installation of a new high intensity activated crosswalk (HAWK) signal. See details below.
- Re-stripe the roadway to include a ladder-style crosswalk along the Highline Canal.
- Apply a pavement preservation treatment to match the existing pavement.
- Existing 24th Street pedestrian bridge and bench feature has been relocated further east to accommodate an additional crossing over the canal.

## What to Expect:

- Construction will begin the week of January 10, 2022. Anticipated completion is two months.
- Work hours will generally be Monday Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Some weekend work may occur.
- During work hours, traffic will be maintained in both directions.
- Alternate routes are encouraged whenever possible.
